3. AVG: Er worden beeldopnamen gemaakt die (kunnen) worden uitgezonden. Indien u niet in beeld wilt komen, meldt u dit dan zelf bij binnenkomst in de kerk? Er wordt dan in overleg met u naar een oplossing gezocht.
4. Blijft u na de zegen nog even zitten voor het orgelspel.
